## Communitywide Health Fair

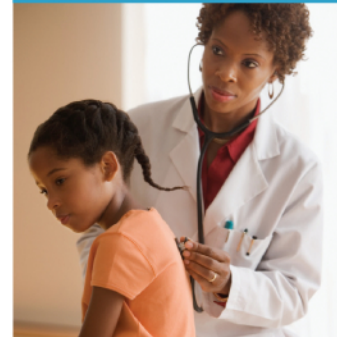
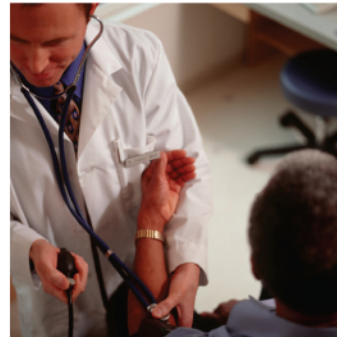
